Explanatory note on the organization of the action "Under the lace sky", held within the framework of The IV International Lace Festival "Vita Lace"

(Vologda, 17 July 2021)

Organizing Authorities of the action "Under the lace sky" are:

- The Department of Culture and Tourism of the Vologda region;
- The Budgetary Institution of Culture of the Vologda Region "Vologda State Museum-Preserve of History, Architecture and Decorative Arts";
- "Vologda State Museum-Preserve" branch "The Museum of Lace".

The action is scheduled for July 17, 2021 within the framework of the IV International Lace Festival "Vita Lace". The result of the action will be the creation of an art object with lace motifs "Under the lace sky" (to commemorate the 60th anniversary of the first human space flight).

Place of the Action: Vologda, Kremlin Square.

Event Date: July 17, 2021 from 10.30 to 12.30

Short Description:

The aim of the action "Under the lace sky" is to attract attention of guests and participants of the IV International Festival "Vita Lace" to the importance of preserving historical memory and strengthening friendly ties between different nations.

As part of the action "Under the lace sky", an art object of the same name will be shown to the general public. The art object will consist of both pre-made lace motifs (stars) and lace items realized by participants during the action.

The image of a star is chosen as the symbol of the action "Under the lace sky". It is a symbol of high aspirations, dreams and hope, understandable to participants from different countries and regions of Russia. Sixty years ago, took place a historic event, which marked the beginning of the exploration of outer space for the benefit of all humanity. On April 12, 1961, was launched

the launch vehicle with the Vostok spacecraft, on which a member of the first cosmonaut corps, 27-year-old Yuri Gagarin, made his legendary flight into space, opening the way for humanity to the stars. The creation of a large-scale art object "Under the Lace Sky" will emphasize the commonality of all people on Earth, their existence in a common outer space, and will also show the uniqueness and originality of each person in this world.

Each participant of the festival, having created his own lace star, will have the opportunity to contribute to the creation of the art object by taking full-time, part-time or correspondence participation in the action.

To organize events within the framework of the IV International Lace Festival "Vita Lace", an Organizing Committee (called further the Committee) is formed from the representatives of the Organizers. The Committee determines the conditions for participation in the action, the time and place of its holding, the plan for the arrangement of workplaces during the action. The Committee introduces this information to the participants of the action.

Conditions of Participation:

- 1. Both organizations and individuals can take part in the action. The age of the participants is not limited.
- 2. The lace works are created by the participants according to the patterns provided by the Organizers.
- 3. Organizations or individuals going to take part in the action "Under the lace sky" need to fill in the registration form, answering "yes" in the appropriate column and send it to the Committee (e-mail: lacefestival@mail.ru or at the address: 160000, Russia, Vologda, S. Orlova St., 15, Vologda State Museum-Reserve).
- 4. When registering, participants can choose the format of participation (full-time, part-time or correspondence participation).
- 4.1. For correspondence participation, it is necessary to complete the work in advance, according to the pattern provided by the organizers and send it to the Organizing Committee before July 01, 2021.
- 4.2. For part-time participation, you need first to complete the lace item and give it personally to the representatives of the Organizers when registering for the festival.
- 4.3. For full-time participation, the personal presence of the participant is required during the entire period of the action on the Kremlin Square. The task of the participants is to complete the lace item within the time allotted by the Organizers (2 hours).
- 4.4. Those who is going to participate in the action in person must have their own lace-making tools (stand, pillow and bobbins) and their own pattern with the started lace item.
- 5. After receiving the registration form, representatives of the Organizing Committee contact the participants to explain the further algorithm of actions and provide the pattern.
- 6. Lace pattern is the result of intellectual activity. The exclusive right to the pattern belongs to the Organizers. The copyright holder provides the participant with the pattern only for the purpose of using it within the framework of the organization and preparation of the action "Under the lace sky". The use (reproduction, distribution, public display, communication to the public, etc.) of the result of intellectual activity for other purposes is unacceptable.
- 7. An unlimited number of realized lace items is accepted from one participant.
- 8. All registered participants of the action who have provided a ready-made lace motif for placement at the art object will be awarded with diplomas of the festival participant. The

diplomas of the festival participant will be sent electronically to the email address indicated in the registration form.

Lace Requirements:

- 1. The finished lace should not exceed the following dimensions: Pattern N_{2} 13x13 cm (height x width); Patter N_{2} 16x7 cm (height x width);
- 2. Lace items must be made strictly of metallized thread (gold or silver colors).
- 3. When making the lace item, it is allowed to use additional materials (beads, rhinestones), but without changing the general appearance of the pattern.
- 4. Additional recommendations for the realization of the lace will be sent to the participants along with the pattern.

Conditions for Accepting Work for Correspondence Participation:

You can transfer the finished lace item to the Lace Museum at the address: Vologda, Kremlin Square, 12. from 10.00 to 17.00 (tel. (8172) 72-16-56).

Lace item can also be sent by post to the address: 160000, Russia, Vologda, st. S. Orlova, 15, Vologda State Museum-Reserve marked with the action "Under the lace sky". Postage is paid by the sender.

The deadline for accepting finished lace items is July 01, 2021. In the case of sending works by post, the date indicated on the postmark is taken into account.

Conditions for Accepting Work for Part-time Participation:

The previously made lace item is given by the participant personally to the representatives of the Organizers when registering for the festival on July 14 and 15, 2021.

Conditions for Accepting Work for Full-time Participation:

After the end of the action, the finished lace items are transferred by the participants to the representatives of the Organizing Committee for placement at the art object "Under the lace sky".

In any format of participation, works are accepted on a gratuitous basis (they are not given or sent back to the participants). The organizers guarantee that all lace items that meet the requirements will be included in the art object "Under the lace sky", which will be demonstrated within the framework of the IV International Lace Festival "Vita Lace".
